Quidditch Championship Coming to Macomb This Weekend

The best of the Midwest region compete in a gender integrated full-contact sport

MACOMB, IL - In November, the best quidditch teams from the Midwest will gather at Veteran's Park in Macomb, IL to determine the regional champion. Over a dozen teams and over 250 players from Colorado, Iowa, Illinois, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin will be in attendance November 21 and 22, 2015 for the Midwest Regional Quidditch Championship. The top four teams will qualify for the US Quidditch Cup 9, to be held in Columbia, South Carolina this spring. This event is free and open to the public.

Real-life quidditch has swept the nation as a fast paced, gender integrated, full-contact adaptation of the sport from the *Harry Potter* books, with more than 170 official teams, 4,000 players, nine annual championship events, and hundreds of thousands of fans. Quidditch is played with seven players to a team, all mounted on brooms. They score points with the quaffle (a volleyball) and the snitch, a neutral yellow-clad athlete who tries to avoid capture, similar to flag football.
